The CHN is a bilingual web site that delivers quality health information to Canadians through a collaborative network of over 20 major non-profit organizations across Canada funded by the Public Health Agency of Canada.

The CHN collection includes more than 20,000 reliable Canadian health information resources from hundreds of websites across the country. Resources in the [Health Promotion section of CHN](#) focus on the social determinants of health, population health, healthy public policy, strategies, and cross-cutting topics such as chronic disease prevention and healthy lifestyles. We invite you to [look through our resources](#) ("Guided Search" on the Health Promotion page).

The [Ontario Prevention Clearinghouse](#) and the [UofT Centre for Health Promotion](#) have partnered as CHN's Health Promotion Affiliate for the last three years. During that time, we have been rebuilding the Health Promotion collection on CHN (still ongoing), and working with CHN Division to strengthen the health promotion focus across CHN. Most recently, CHN has begun to implement a new Quality Assurance Framework to maintain the currency, authority, and non-commercial nature of CHN resources.

It would be very valuable to get your input as Community Health provider on how we could improve the Health Promotion collection on the CHN.
