Evidence into Action: Housing is HIV Prevention and Care

CALL FOR ABSTRACTS

The National AIDS Housing Coalition (NAHC) and the Ontario HIV Treatment Network (OHTN), in collaboration with the Johns Hopkins Bloomberg School of Public Health, are pleased to convene the fifth Housing and HIV/AIDS Research Summit. The Summit has provided an interdisciplinary, interactive forum for the presentation of research findings on the relationship of housing status and HIV prevention and care, and continued dialogue on public policy implications and strategies since 2005.

The theme of the 2010 Summit is *Evidence into Action: Housing is HIV Prevention and Care*, with a focus on evidence-based policy and practice that targets housing as a key social determinant of HIV risk and health outcomes. Summit organizers invite abstracts that reflect this theme from:

- Scientific research
- Economic analyses
- Program evaluations
- Community-based interventions

Of particular interest is work that broadens our understanding of:

- Housing need among populations disproportionately impacted by HIV/AIDS, including Aboriginal Peoples in Canada, African Americans, Alaskan Natives, American Indians, Black Canadians, and people of African, Asian, Caribbean and Latino descent living in North America.
- Work in areas of emerging housing need, such as persons re-entering the community from prison or jail, victims of violence and other forms of trauma, and military veterans.

International research is welcome.

ABSTRACT SUBMISSION

Abstracts must be submitted online via the [Research Summit website](#) for oral and poster presentations. Abstracts may be no more than 600 words and must include the presentation title and a complete list of authors including affiliations.
