BACKGROUND

The Partnership is the principal supporter of the CCRA, and the importance of cancer prevention research was recognized in action item one of the CCRA's Pan-Canadian Cancer Research Strategy published in May 2010. The development of a cancer prevention research plan was the first priority for action identified in the strategy report. This online workspace is designed to engage research, practice and policy stakeholders across Canada in reviewing and refining the third draft of the framework. The workspace will remain open until February 3, 2012. A fourth and final draft will be developed in February 2012 for review and approval by the CCRA Board and member organizations in March 2012.
