- **Assess** - create a scorecard showing your project's strengths and limitations.
- **Analyze** - identify and emphasize the risks and benefits of your project.
- **Advise** - draw conclusions about the overall impact of your project.

Work on one business case, work on many business cases! Copy your business case and tailor it for other audiences.
